IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Club Membership - Please note for insurance purposes all riding participants must be club members or EA members and membership must be paid prior to entering the event. A Dangerous Activity Form must be completed along with membership.

FNEG now offers Day Membership for \$15/day. Riders are only eligible to be a Day member at one competition. Full membership must then be taken out.

All riders under 18 years MUST be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.

Conditions of Entry

Before entering, all competitors should read the FNEG conditions of entry (available on website) and the Equestrian Australia Dressage Rules

Please make special note of your age group parameters if you are a junior rider. If you need further clarification, please email the FNEG secretary fneg.info@gmail.com.

There is a maximum of two tests / day for each horse and rider combination. Riders may only compete in two consecutive levels ie. Preparatory/Preliminary, Preliminary/Novice etc

A Horse Health Biosecurity form MUST be completed for ALL horses attending at the weekend and handed in at the start of the event.

Gear Check

From 1 January 2024 Gear check is now directly after your test. Please stay mounted and do not remove any of your gear and make your way directly to the Steward at the Gear Check marquee. The steward / Marshall will also conduct a visual check before you enter the competition arena. If you have any questions about your gear, prior to your test, if you have doubts / just want to double check, please ask our Steward they are always there to help!

Horse ID Numbers

Horse ID Numbers are to be displayed by all riders including Closed Restricted Riders. Horse ID numbers are to be displayed on both sides of your horse's bridle or saddle cloth (when riding) and your horse's halter when out of the stable or tied up at your float. Horse ID numbers are to be black font on white with the numbers between 3.5-4cm tall. If you do not have a Horse ID number or forgot to provide it in your nomination, you will be allocated one. You can find the Horse ID Number in the draw near your name - please use this number for the remainder of the 2024 competition season.

Helmets Tagging has been mandatory for all EA Affiliated Dressage events from 1 July 2022.

Please ensure your helmet has been checked and tagged by an authorised EA Helmet Tagger prior to mounting your horse for warmup or competition. FNEG will have an authorised Helmet Tagger available at Gear Check.

Remember, ensuring that your helmet is compliant and safe is always the responsibility of the athlete and a compliant helmet is mandatory under the EA General Regulations. Helmet tagging only indicates that the helmet complies with current EA standards.

Event tasks

All participants are required to help with event tasks, for each horse entered it is expected you could be asked to volunteer for 2 hours of tasks. Please indicate your preference on the entry form. A task will be assigned to you and presented on the draw, so please check the draw for you allocated task. If you are unable to undertake a task it will be your responsibility to **find someone to fill in (do the task) for you.**

Ribbons & Prize Money
